Also, as a special musical treat, I have enlisted the help of my friend and colleague, Susan Foster, concert organist and organist (retired) of Home Moravian Church to play several major organ works during the service. I will assist as page turner and stop puller, so it's going to be a real tag-team effort!

This coming Advent will mark the start of my 7th year as your Director of Music and given my penchant for things new and different, I have decided to try to form a choir for a one-time performance at the Xmas Eve Service. All I ask is a commitment to attend three 90 minute rehearsals starting the first week of December. We need a critical mass of at least 6 singers to make this happen, so please consider joining. There will be a signup sheet in the narthex or simply speak to me after the service if you have any questions. Remember, singing is like praying twice!

Clocks go back 1 hour Sunday, November 5th.


Advent Wreath Workshop
